

List of Acceptable Documents - ECA

Identity proofing requires the applicant to provide two official identification credentials, at least one of which must be a photo ID. IDs are to be presented to the authorized individual performing the in-person confirmation of identity.

Two of the three boxes on the Part 2: In-person Identification Form **must be filled in completely.**

List A - IDs to confirm Identity & Citizenship:

- Valid U.S. passport
- United States Certificate of Naturalization
- Certificate of Citizenship issued by USCIS
- Valid passport issued by country(ies) of citizenship

List B – Government-issued Photo ID card to confirm Identity:

- Valid state-issued driver's license
- Valid state-issued state ID
- Valid U.S. military ID
- U.S. federal government employee photo ID

List C – For U.S. Citizens to confirm Identity & Citizenship:

- Certified birth certificate issued by city, county or state of birth
- Certification of Report of Birth (DoS form DS-1350)
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad (DoS form FS-240)

The forms of ID presented must be free of any apparent defect on their face and must be within their validity periods as of the date that the in-person identification is performed. The photograph must be recognizable as belonging to the applicant.

In the event of a name change, please also present the original, or a notarized copy of the name-change documentation (marriage certificate, divorce decree, court-issued name change documents) and include a copy with the forms packet when submitting for processing.
